It is the first Australian film to be distributed in India since 2016.

From the early stages of writing to the final cut, the Indian directors and their professiona teams mentored the local cast and crew, and were in Melbourne for each of the shoots.

Featuring in the films are acclaimed Australian actors Kat Stewart (OFFSPRING), and Arka Das (LION), cricket coach and legendary player Brad Hodge, Hindi star Arushi Sharma, Nathan Borg -the first deaf actor to appear in Neighbours, and a number of exciting new talents, such as Afghanistan refugee and budding cricket star Setara Amiri, each playing roles close their own lived experiences.

The title track of MY MELBOURNE is sung by Janaki Eshwar, known for being the youngest contestant on 'The Voice Australia and a highly accomplished singer, and Parvyn Kaur Singh, the former frontwoman of the cult band, The Bombay Royale. The second track, Azadi, has been sung in both Hindi and Dari by Aryana Sayeed, who is one of Afghanistan's most loved and inspiring singers and activists, dubbed 'the Taylor Swift of Afghanistan'.
